

Grade 5: Module 3A: Unit 3: Recommended Texts







Unit 3 builds students' background knowledge of Althea Gibson and Roberto Clemente and how these athletes broke racial barriers and created legacies. The list below includes texts with a range of Lexile text measures on this topic. This provides appropriate independent reading for each student to help build content knowledge.

It is imperative that students read a high volume of texts at their reading level to continue to build the academic vocabulary and fluency demanded by the CCLS.

Common Core Band Level Text Difficulty Ranges:

(As provided in the NYSED Passage Selection Guidelines for Assessing CCSS ELA)

- Grade 2-3: 420-820L
- Grade 4-5: 740-1010L
- Grade 6-8: 925-1185L

Where possible, texts in languages other than English are also provided. Texts are categorized into three Lexile ranges that correspond to Common Core Bands: below-grade band, within band, and above-grade band. Note, however, that Lexile measures are just one indicator of text complexity, and teachers must use their professional judgment and consider qualitative factors as well.
