Linguistic Demands: The following are examples in English that may vary based on the language of instruction. In the first three levels (entering, emerging and transitioning), students can approach these linguistic demands in the new and/or home language.

Use who, what, where, why and how question forms based on the text to seek help, information or clarification: *Did you notice what ___ said? Who just said that?*Where did you say it happened? When? Can you help me with ___?

Example to Address the Linguistic Demands
